LAW ENFORCEMENT

The 143rd LE class will complete **Defensive Tactics, Interactions in a Diverse Community, Interviewing and Report Writing** and most of **Fundamentals of Patrol** this month.

The 144th LE class starts on September 12th and there are thirty-five students enrolled. They will complete **Introduction to Law Enforcement, Legal and First Aid** this month.

The 74th CO to LE full-time Crossover class will complete **Criminal Investigations, Crime Scene to Courtroom** and **Critical Incidents** this month.

The 75th CO to LE Crossover class starts on September 12th and there are eighteen students enrolled. They will complete **Introduction to Law Enforcement** and most of **Legal** this month.

We have already begun the application process for the 145th LE class scheduled for January and the 146th LE class scheduled for March. As of this writing we already have over fifty applicants. The application for these classes ends on October 7th, 2016. All of the pertinent information needed for applying can be found on our website (www.swfpsa.org).

Everything on the Law Enforcement side is looking very good. On any given day there will be as many as 103 LE students on campus.

As always, stop by when you have the opportunity and tour our campus. I think that you will be impressed with our students and faculty.
