LAW ENFORCEMENT

The 141st LE class will be finishing **Critical Incidents, Traffic Stops, DUI Traffic Stops and Traffic Crash Investigations**. They graduate on May 31st at 6 PM @ Dunbar High School.

The 73rd CO to LE class will complete **Criminal Investigations and Crime Scene to Courtroom** this month.
