CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACADEMY

LAW ENFORCEMENT

The 140th LE class is now the senior class in the Academy. They will complete **Criminal Investigations, Crime Scene to Courtroom** and **Critical Incidents** in January. In this class we have thirteen sponsored and twenty-one Open Enrollment students. We have had recruiters visit us from the East Coast and Northern Florida. We also have a number of students in the hiring process locally. I expect at least eight to ten more to be sponsored by the time they graduate on February 18th. If any of our local recruiters are reading this you are always welcome to visit us and talk to the students.

The 72nd CO to LE class is moving right along and will have completed **Vehicle Operations** by the end of this month. They will graduate here at the Academy on February 11th.

The 141st LE class starts on January 11th. As of this writing there are sixteen sponsored and sixteen open enrollment students in the class. During the month of January they will complete **Intro to LE, Legal** and **First Aid**.

Everything on the Law Enforcement side is looking very good. On any given day there will be as many as 90 LE students on campus.

As always, stop by when you have the opportunity and tour our campus. I think that you will be impressed with our students and faculty.

Corrections class 142 graduated on December 7th, here at the academy. The class ended up with 18 students graduating. They took the state exam on December 17th, with 17 out of 18 passing on the first attempt and the 18th student tightened up and passed on his second attempt. This gave us a 95% average on the first take of exam. Congratulations to all graduating students and we look forward to seeing you soon as you attend advanced and specialized classes throughout your career!

Corrections class 143 will begin on January 11th and we will start off with their **Physical Fitness Assessment** and **Introduction to Corrections** on the first day. The class is scheduled to have 28 students with 13 sponsored Lee County SO students, 6 sponsored Collier County SO students and 9 open enrollment students.

FIRE ACADEMY

High school fire class 1516 is going strong with 25 students attending the FF1 portion as seniors. They are continuing to advance into more practical and hands on applications of the program including PPE, Hose, Streams and Supply.

The academy hosted a Fire December Cooperative training for area fire departments. During the three day training, over 60 fire evolutions were completed and over 200 area firefighters attended.

The academy hosted an EVOC, Fire Service Hydraulics and Apparatus Operations classes at the academy. Over 80 area FF's attended.

The academy completed its first EMT course orientation with 19 students for the upcoming January EMT Course.

Class 1601 Firefighter and Class 1601 EMT are both starting in January of 2016.
