## **Applicant Selection Process: Points System**

The following point system is designed to help the Southwest Florida Public Service Academy (SWFPSA) determine which applicants will be admitted into limited access Fire and/or EMS courses. Our goal is to select applicants that will have the best opportunity to successfully complete our programs, achieve industry certification, and subsequently gain employment. Please note that course admission preference will be given to agency sponsored candidates.

In the event that there are more qualified applicants than seats available in the current class offering, those applicants that are not initially selected will remain on the list as an "alternate". Alternates will only be used to fill the remaining spots in the event that one becomes available before the start of the course. Once the course starts, the remaining applicants will have to reapply for future offerings. We DO NOT form "wait-lists" for future class offerings.
