Hello,

We welcome you to the Southwest Florida Public Service Academy and hope you enjoy and benefit from the course of instruction you have chosen.

It is the policy of the School District of Lee County that **photo identification be worn and visible at all times (if not in full agency uniform)** while on any of the District campuses. It is especially important here on our campus due to the fact that we are a quasi-military structure and that we also have firearms on campus.

The following dress code for Advanced & Specialized courses will be strictly adhered to and enforced:

CERTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT/CORRECTIONS

Option 1: Full agency uniform

Option 2: Authorized Department training uniform, such as full BDU's or department Polo shirt and slacks. All shirts must be tucked in. If you choose to carry your firearm exposed, your badge and photo ID must clearly be visible at all times.

CIVILIAN/UNDER-COVER

Casual business attire, which will include collared shirt and full-length business appropriate pants/trousers. Shirts must be tucked in.

Failure to comply with this policy will result in you being asked to immediately correct the violation, if the violation of is not corrected you will be asked to leave the campus immediately.

Not all the agencies issue identification suitable to be worn, some being wallet carried. If that is the case, please stop by the office upon your arrival or see your instructor and our staff will gladly issue you an identification tag.

Regardless of which option you may choose, you must wear visible I.D. while on campus.

The south parking lot is for staff and faculty only, not students attending classes, or instructors attending classes. There is a sign that indicates the area is for faculty and staff only. If you are an Instructor attending class as a student, park in parking lots designated for student parking. Thank you
