Live Fire Training Instructor: ATPC-3530

Description: This 40-hour course will identify and assist the student in understanding the regulations, rules and requirements of conducting live fire training. The course is based on NFPA 1402, "Guide to Building Fire Service Training Centers" and NFPA 1403, "Standard on Live Fire Training Evolutions." This course is required by the State of Florida for Fire Service Instructors who will be participating as Live Fire Instructors in live fire training evolutions in acquired structures and at certified training facilities. Certification as a 40-hour instructor meets the requirements to act as an Instructor in Charge (IIC) or as a Safety Officer. This curriculum is designed to deliver a comprehensive live fire training program, within a safe and controlled environment, in accordance with NFPA 1402, NFPA 1403, and NFPA 1500. Both lecture and practical will be used allowing participants to apply knowledge of the above standards to training activities.
